## HISTORY

In the fall of 2015 4Sight, Inc., a local nonprofit, approached the administration of J.O. Johnson High School and the CyberJagzz were born. During that first year Team 442, Redstone Robotics, located at New Century High School, mentored the CyberJagzz and got us on our feet as a Rookie team.

After our Rookie season the CyberJagzz were on our own. For the 2016-17 season the team moved to Mae C. Jemison High School. We have been there ever since. The team is not exclusively Jemison students – it has always functioned as a community team open to students from the community.

During our third year the Rotary Club of Greater Huntsville provided financial support and a couple of mentors. The team continued to grow, and at the beginning of the 2019-20 season we moved into the Physics Lab in Jemison's College Academy as our home base.

After staying relatively inactive during the pandemic years, we began to grow again during the 2021-22 school year. We traveled to South Carolina for our first ever out-of-state event.

During the first semester the team meets twice a week to learn the skills needed to design and build a robot. During the second semester the team meets more frequently and actually designs and builds a robot for the spring competition.

The Rotary Club of Greater Huntsville and the Greater Huntsville Rotary Foundation continue to support our team, but as we continue to grow, we find we need additional support.

## STUDENTS



We are a small team that is striving to grow in number. Our school is a Title 1 school and has around 64% of students from low-income families. Our students do not have to pay anything to participate in robotics. Your sponsorship will allow our team to participate fully in the competition.

- Average 35% girls and 65% boys

## IMPACT OF FIRST

FIRST Robotics Competition positively impacts students in the following ways:

- Students learn from professional engineers and master STEM skills.
- Students learn to use professional level software, hardware, and power tools.
- Students design and build a robot each season.
- Students experience teamwork and learn communication skills.
- Students cooperate with other teams in alliances.
- Students practice Gracious Professionalism™ and explain the concept to others.
- Juniors and Seniors can qualify for college scholarships offered through FIRST.



## COMPETITIONS

We participate in the FIRST Robotics Competition Rocket City Regional held each year at the VBC. We have recently started going to a second out-of-state regional.

We must qualify to attend the National Championship held in April, and we don't get to go every year. If we do qualify, we incur additional registration and travel expenses.

As we grow our team, we will attempt to attend Off Season events during the summers and fall semester. Off Season events are scaled down, unofficial, competitions held in various parts of the country.
